### Instructions for filing for mooring permit.

**All boats or vessels** must file for a permit (13 ft and up) if they are going to be docked, birthed, or on a mooring within the Town of Norwell by **May 15** each year.

**All persons** shall fill out permit form 1 and return it to the Harbormaster with the **\$15.00** registration fee and the **\$2.50** per ft. fee made out to the Town of Norwell.

[ example ] **Permit fee** \$15.00 21ft **boat** @ \$2.50 = \$52.50 **Total** \$67.50

Permits must be **renewed each year**, renewals will have no fee. Only the per foot fee shall apply.

If you have paid your boat excise tax to the Town of Norwell just indicated that on the form and it will be checked with the treasure office. **If not** fill out form 28E1 and return it with your application and next year's tax will go to the town.

Mooring inspection form **should only be filled out** when you have your mooring inspected or replaced, have your mooring service provider fill it out.

**Decal placement** will be on the port (left) side of the transom near the top of the rail area.

A **numbered plastic colored seal** will be placed on the mooring ball or dock area by the Harbormaster where the vessel is tied up, after his visual inspection is complete this seal will indicate that the mooring area is registered with the Town of Norwell.
